It is so powerful to see our entire school learning about this Canadian hero and then to put their empathy & care into action as the bring in donations and then run "across Canada". Thank you to Mrs. James and her amazing team of volunteers. Also, thank you to the parents that came to cheer on the students as they gave their all.

I also want to take this opportunity to briefly address the other big event that happened last week. On September 20<sup>th</sup>, some families did not send their child(ren) to school due to anti-SOGI protests. In talking with many parents, it is clear that there has been a lot of misinformation circulating, resulting in confusion and worry about what is, and is not, being taught in our school.

#### WHAT IS SOGI 123?

SOGI stands for Sexual Orientation & Gender Identity. SOGI 123 was added to the Ministry of Education in 2016. SOGI 123 is NOT a curriculum nor a set of lessons teachers must teach, it refers to resources and information that teachers may choose to access/include to diversify their classroom approach. These optional resources are created to help students understand the negative impacts of discrimination and to improve awareness and understanding of the diverse people around them.

#### WHAT DO WE TEACH AT SOUTH POPLAR?

I want to start by reassuring our families that the most common and important "SOGI" message that our students receive is about erasing discrimination and embracing inclusion. At South Poplar we welcome all students and their families into our school. We strive to create safe spaces. We respect our families and their individual choices. We celebrate inclusion and diversity, including, but not limited to, diverse races, cultures, abilities, sexual orientations, gender identities, and more. As stated in our diversity statement, found below and in every newsletter.

The impact of being a SOGI-inclusive school at the Elementary level, and at South Poplar specifically, is that teachers are working to be more intentionally inclusive (valuing diversity, respecting differences, and responding to discrimination). This can include things like:

- incorporating books with diverse characters
- including family examples that are not only the traditional mom & dad
- discussing and dismantling stereotypes (i.e. girls can't do this, boys can't do that)

Regarding BC's Health curriculum, it does include topics like:

- K & Gr. 1: names for private parts, and appropriate/inappropriate touch
- Gr. 2 & 3: skills for unsafe situations and factors that influence self-identity
- Gr. 4 & 5: physical, emotional, and social changes that occur during puberty (including those involving sexuality and sexual identity)

Teachers are responsible for approaching each of these topics with information and resources that are developmentally and age appropriate for the children that they teach.

Please also note that before puberty lessons are taught in grades 4 & 5, parents are notified, provided with information about the content that will be covered, and we have to receive signed permission forms for each student.

#### HAVE QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS?

Parents are strongly encouraged to be curious and ask their child(ren)'s teacher what is (or is not) being taught. Our teachers are happy to explain what is happening in the classroom. Step 3- Enter your unique code provided on the paper given to your student on photo day Step 4- View Images.

Step 5 - Select 'Buy Now' and you will be able to select from a variety of packages, single photo sheets and bonus items. Select product that you want to purchase and then choose which image you want to add to the product.

Step 6 – Add to cart. Select school delivery or choose ship to home (minimal shipping charge)

Photo orders must be placed by the end of day Thursday, October 5th to be included in the first delivery to school. Photo orders will be delivered to the school approximately one week after this date.
