UPHOLDING THE DRESS CODE @ SOUTH POPLAR

One of our school's tenets is that we have a dress code. The dress code has been established to:

- ★ Help develop a strong school focus and team spirit
- ★ Give students a sense of belonging to our school
- ★ Discourage competition based on clothing

Last summer, we updated our dress code by adding a few items (ie. the light blue polo, navy crested polo dress and the Wildcat T), and providing clarification around other items (ie. tights must be solid BLACK, GREY, NAVY, or WHITE). We have allowed several months for families to learn about , and to understand the expectations.

Starting in April, we will be supporting this tenet and expectation in more intentional ways. (This means that staff will be working together to help tighten up the expectations on following our dress code.)

- Reminder notes will be sent home in planners, along with a paper copy of our "Detailed Dress Code Requirements"
- Infractions will also be documented & shared with the office
- Multiple infractions will be addressed by administration

Our students are proud to wear their South Poplar crest and to clearly show that they are a Wildcat. Let's work together to bring better "uniformity" to our dress code.

INFRACTION (DOES NOT MEET DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS)	EXPECTATION (WHAT STUDENTS SHOULD BE WEARING INSTEAD)
Wearing hoodies or non-crested sweaters inside of the school/classroom.	These can be worn outside (similar to wearing a jacket), but they are not to be worn inside. Inside, students can wear any of our crested
	items (sweatshirt, V-neck sweater, or cardigan)
Wearing patterned tights under skirts.	All tights/leggings worn under skirts must be SOLID black, grey, navy, or white.
 Pants that do NOT match the dress code Wearing jogging pants Wearing leggings/tights as pants 	 ALL pants & shorts must have: Front & back pockets (real or faux) Zipper/fly (real or faux) ONLY EXCEPTION: "Navy Rugby Pants" (available through Able Cresting)
Clothing that has been unofficially crested (somewhere other than Able Cresting) that does not fit our dress code (ie. a white crested polo)
