- Jerseys

Kim Hooper got a quote - 2 options: 1 is the current jersey (both side, jersey \# and wild cat log, in 1 color) $\$ 4791.60$ plus tax. $2^{\text {nd }}$ quote is for same thing but in all 6 colours $\$ 5731.00$ plus tax. We will come under budget with both quotes (vote to spend up to $\$ 7000$ between gaming and general accounts was done at the June mtg, so this is a presentation of the options...the entire group completely supported the all colour option.)
Question: Who gets to wear the jerseys? Response by Mrs. Manky: Every student in grades 4 and 5 have to participate in track and field so all students will get to wear the jerseys at some point in their South Pop experience, and if students participate in extracurricular activities (soccer, basketball) they get to wear it then also

Intent is for extra-curricular activities
They will take payment via cheque then they will start processing the order Suggestion to take the entire amount out of gaming, now that our funds have arrived. Group discussed options. Motion to spend the total amount of the jerseys from gaming: Reena Second: Adam - Motion carried

- Soccer nets

Pricing for larger nets are $\$ 136$, smaller nets $\$ 96.00$ + taxes
Need 4 big and 6 small nets
Money comes to about $\$ 1120.00$ with taxes for nets. Motion to spend up to
$\mathbf{\$ 1 4 0 0}$.00 on soccer nets, from gaming: Adam Second: Sukhi C - Motion carried

- Grade 5 farewell

PAC traditionally gives $\$ 10$ / student 42 grade 5 students this year(there are 44 spots in grade 5 this year) - Motion to spend up to $\$ 440$ out of gaming for grade 5
farewell: Adam Second: Sukhi C - Motion carried

Question: Funds provided by PAC to teachers (\$250) Can PAC also provide it to the support staff? Response from Mrs. Manky: School also provides \$250 to teachers on top of the $\mathbf{\$ 2 5 0}$ they get from PAC and the support staff gets a larger budget from school as they do not get it from PAC, so they still get the additional funds. If the PAC is providing to classroom teachers, then all the students benefit equally.

Sukhi C: Is there an update on the suggestion she had provided for a Reptile day in Nov? Answer: Unfortunately there was not enough time to coordinate this but Mrs. Manky has made a note of it as an option for 2024/2025 school year.
